- Shirt: white business shirt with school logo provided during orientation.
- Jumper: White jumper with AVI logo, this is as per order basis only.

HEALTHCARE UNIFORM

• Grey scrub suit with logo provided by school.

HOSPITALITY UNIFORM

- Top: Dark blue polo provided by school.
- Bottom: Any dark blue or black pants.
- Apron: Khaki with logo, provided by school.
- Hat: Khaki with logo, provided by school.

All uniforms must be worn accordingly, school shirts will be worn during class. During simulation day and work placements, students studying aged care and kitchen management and hospitality should wear their course uniform.

During orientation, students will be provided one set of uniform. If student need additional uniform, the student can purchase in the student service desk between Monday to Friday 9am to 5.00pm.
